

## Sticky Knowledge:

- To know what information to keep private.
- To know different strategies to be discerning in evaluating digital content (ie. checking the user's email address; knowing which sources are trustworthy).
- To know why someone else might change their identity depending on what they are doing online (e.g. gaming; using an avatar; social media).
- To know what makes a strong password.

## Password

A secret string of letters, symbols, and numbers that you can use to restrict who can access something digital

## Glossary:

- Data - information in digital form
- Information - data that is transmitted by a computer
- Report concerns - sharing worries with someone who can help you
- Search engine - software system that carries out searches on the internet
- Personal information - any information about a person that is recorded that can identify that person
- Acceptable - satisfactory or approved of
- Unacceptable - not satisfactory or disapproved of
- Engage - interact over the internet with someone

**Threats** – When someone says something bad will happen if you don't do what they say.

**Flattery** – When someone says really, really nice things about you.

**Bribery** – When someone offers you something in return for doing something.

**Too good to be true offers** – When someone says they will do or give you something so good that it doesn't seem possible.
