Vocabulary Focus:

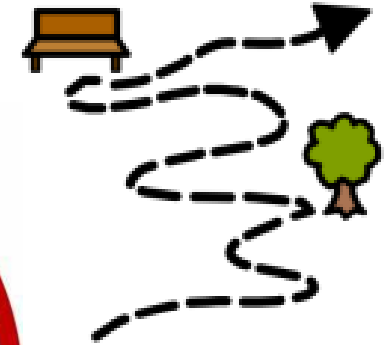
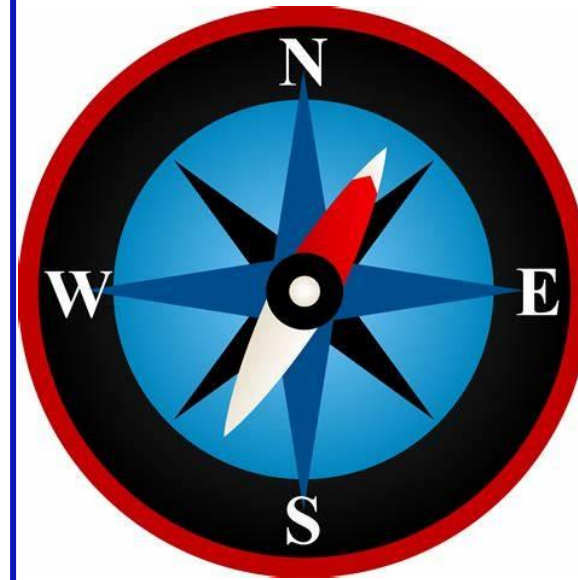
route – a particular way of getting from one place to another. It marks the start and end of a journey.
