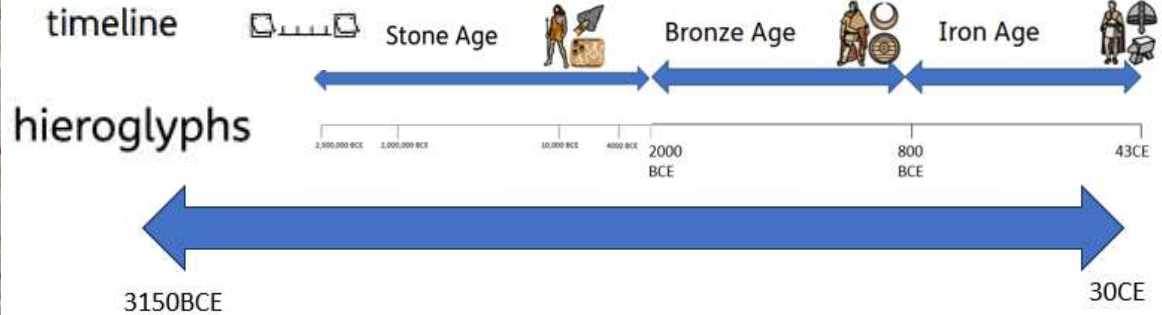


Year 3 – Spring/Summer – What was significant about the Ancient Egyptian civilisation?
