

Science - Year 2 - Spring 2 - How do plants grow?

What I need to know by the end of this unit:

- A seed is a small part of a plant that grows into a new plant.
- Many plants that we eat grow from seeds.
- A bulb is a plant bud which begins to grow underground.
- Plants need certain conditions for them to grow healthily.



Vocabulary Focus:

conditions - something that must be present or happen in order for something else to occur.

seed - a small part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant.

sow - to plant something.

bulb - a plant bud which begins to grow underground.

temperature - how hot or cold the environment is.

What conditions have you discovered are needed by plants to grow well?

Conditions plants need to grow healthily:
