Vocabulary Focus:

Pattern - A pattern is when shapes, lines, or colours are repeated

Layer - something placed on top of another to build up colours, textures, and patterns.

Technique - is a **way** of doing something

Primary colours are colours that cannot be created by mixing other colours together.

Secondary colours are colours created by mixing two primary colours.
